The design of the Mingx collection issues from the same tubular profile that also inspired the bookcase Zigzag, and develops into an extensive family of elements: seats, stools and tables, which establish a harmonious mutual dialogue that also extends to the bookcase. The name Mingx clearly refers to the Ming dynasty that most influenced the progress of chinese culture, turning China into the heart of eastern trade. The tables with american walnut top and tubular steel frame are proposed in the flush version, like the writing desk and the low table. The Mingx collection is also proposed in the outdoor version with quartzite and sheet metal table tops and frames subjected to protective cataphoresis treatment.

Structure in printed steel sheet and rod epoxy painted. Feet in abs. Mdf top canaletto walnut veneer thickness 16 mm. Indoor use only.
